

# RESORT VILLAGE OF TURTLE VIEW

## Bylaw No. 23-2021

A Bylaw to Regulate the use of Fireworks within the Boundaries of the Resort Village of Turtle View.

The Council of the Resort Village of Turtle View in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

### Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as “The Fireworks Bylaw”.

### Purpose

2. The Purpose of this Bylaw is to regulate the use of fireworks in the Resort Village of Turtle View.

### Definitions

3. Whenever in this bylaw, the following words or terms are used, they shall, unless the text otherwise provides, be held to have the following meaning:
  - a) Council: shall mean the Council of the Resort Village of Turtle View.
  - b) Fire Brigade Chief: shall mean the person, or their designate who is appointed to be the head of the Resort Village of Turtle View Volunteer Fire Brigade.
  - c) Fireworks: shall mean and include any combustible or explosive composition, or any substance or combination of substances, or article prepared for the purpose of providing a visible or an audible effect by combustion, explosion, deflagration or detonation; and shall include blank cartridges, toy pistols, toy canons or toy guns in which explosives are used; firecrackers, torpedoes, sky rockets, roman candles, daygo bombs, sparklers or other fireworks of like construction and any fireworks containing any explosive or flammable compound; or any tablets or other devices containing any explosive or flammable substance.
  - d) Minor: shall mean a person under the age of eighteen (18).

### Regulations

4.
  - a) No minor shall be in possession of fireworks.
  - b) Except as hereunder provided, it shall be unlawful and an offense for any person to use or discharge any fireworks in the Resort Village of Turtle View unless a Special Permit, attached hereto as Schedule A, has been received at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the display. Every such display shall be handled by a competent operator approved by the Volunteer Fire Brigade Chief or their designate.
  - c) All permits issued pursuant to this Bylaw shall be subject to such conditions, restrictions and provisions as the Resort Village may consider necessary and expedient to incorporate therein.
  - d) Upon receiving a permit, which is not transferable, all fireworks approved shall be used as set out in the permit for the event specified. Any fireworks that remain unused or unfired after the display is concluded shall be immediately disposed of in a safe manner.
  - e) The person or organization responsible for setting off of fireworks shall carry liability insurance in the amount of one million (\$1,000,000.00) dollars. The

applicant for a permit shall procure and provide to the Turtle View office, at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the scheduled date of the display, a Certificate of Insurance which shall name the Municipality as insured under the applicant's insurance policy. The Insurance Certificate shall indicate that the applicant has at least \$1,000,000.00 of public liability insurance.

#### Offences and Penalties

5. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of subsections of this bylaw or fails to comply therewith or with any of this bylaw or fails to comply therewith or with any notice or order given thereunder shall be guilty of an offence and upon conviction, shall be liable to penalties as follows:

- (a) Section 4(a) \$125.00
- Section 4(b) \$125.00
- Section 4(c) \$125.00
- Section 4(d) \$125.00
- Section 4(e) \$125.00


(b) If the penalties prescribed in subsection (a) are voluntarily paid within thirty (30) days of the date of the offence to the Resort Village of Turtle View, the penalty shall be reduced to \$75.00.

c) If the penalties prescribed in subsection (a) are not paid within thirty (30) days of the date of the offence, an Information may be laid and a Summons issued. Thereafter, voluntary payment may be made before the returnable date of the Summons to the Resort Village of Turtle View. Upon such payment, the person charged shall not be subject to further court action.

d) The Notice of Violation shall be as Appendix "A" attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

6. This bylaw shall come into force and effect upon final passing by the Council of the Resort Village of Turtle View.
