
#### A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Resort Village of Turtle View in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
  - “Administrator” shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
  - “Council” shall mean the council of the municipality; and
  - “Municipality” shall mean the Resort Village of Turtle View.
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with Schedule “A” which is attached to and forming a part of this bylaw.
3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year or 45 days after the person has been invoiced for said services, whichever is earlier.
4. No property owner, renter or lessee within the Resort Village of Turtle View Municipal boundaries can refuse fire services in the event of a fire.
  - This bylaw shall come into effect on November 18, 2020.

**RESORT VILLAGE OF TURTLE VIEW  
SCHEDULE "A"  
TO BYLAW 7-2020**

Council has set the schedule of fees to be the following:

Service Charge for Fires:

- a) Remote supervision where no physical response from the Meadow Lake Fire Department is required
  - Crew wages (firefighters responding to the hall, minimum 1 hour)
  - Command services at \$100.00 per hour
  
- b) Command vehicle only, to provide on-scene supervision
  - \$400.00 per hour including travel time. (Wages for this vehicle to respond are included in this rate)
  
- c) Fire Fighters
  - \$25.00/hour per man/woman per call
  
- d) Fire Truck response to fire or other calls (includes false alarms)
  - 2020:
    - \$957.00 for each fire truck for first hour
    - \$620.00 for each additional hours (including travel)
  - 2021:
    - \$985.00 for each fire truck for first hour
    - \$639.00 for each additional hours (including travel)
  
- e) Other miscellaneous fees:
  - If deemed necessary by the Fire Chief, there may be additional charges which include but are not limited to: equipment rental, water tankers and firefighter sustenance.
