

INVITATION TO TENDER FOR SUMMER GRASS CUTTING FOR THE SUBDIVISIONS OF INDIAN POINT AND GOLDEN SANDS AT THE RESORT VILLAGE OF TURTLE VIEW

OVERVIEW:

The Resort Village of Turtle View requires the services of a contractor for summer grass cutting as described below.

The contractor will provide his own equipment, fuel and manpower required to perform the work described below.

The area involves grass cutting of all of the municipal land in the subdivisions of Indian Point and Golden Sands.

PRICING:

The tenderer is to provide a seasonal price for this work.

The tenderer also shall include an estimate of the total seasonal hours required to provide this service.

An hourly rate is to be provided as well.

An hourly rate will be used should Council determine that extra maintenance work is required in any of the four subdivisions of the Resort Village of Turtle View, during the contract effective period or outside the contract period.

Please note the contract period as shown later in this document.

SUMMER GRASS CUTTING:

- Mow the following areas on a weekly basis or when grass/weeds/dandelions grow more than two inches from last cutting:
 - Ball diamond
 - Three playgrounds - MR3 (in neck of Indian Point), MR5 (south of boat Launch), MR 9 (Aspen Cove)
 - MR 8/9 (by fire hall), MR 3 (in neck of Indian Point), R7 (South end of Golden Sands, beach access)
 - Use trimmer around posts and fences when these areas become overgrown.
- Before every long weekend:
 - Along the sides of all streets and roads including both entrance roads from the t-intersection at the west end of Indian Point and Golden Sands access road into Indian Point and Golden Sands. This should include at least one mower width where the bush is close to the road edge and up to the complete road allowance width where there is no bush to impede the mower. The objective is to cut grass, weeds, dandelions etc. to accomplish a neat visual appearance.
 - Mow as much of each road allowance as is possible up to the tree/bush line in each case. Mow ditches where possible to achieve a pleasing visual appearance.
 - In the case of the two entrance roads, only mow approximately one meter from the road edge into the ditch, up to the first side street in each case.
- Beach areas:
 - Cut grass and weeds in the public swimming areas near the two playground sites and the north beach down to the water's edge where possible.

TENDER CLOSING DATE AND TIME:

Sealed tenders will be received up to 12:00 PM local time on Tuesday, April 16, 2024.

CONTRACT PERIOD:

The contract period will be from May 1, 2024 to September 30, 2024.

SUBMISSION OF TENDER:

Tenders will be received up to the time and date stated.

Please deliver your tender in person to the office, by regular mail or e-mail.

If submitting by regular mail, place tender in a sealed envelope clearly stating the tender description, your name, phone number, address and e-mail address. Those received before the due date will be retained unopened until the opening time and date. It is the responsibility of the tenderer to ensure that their tender is delivered not later than the appointed time.

The tenderer shall obtain and maintain comprehensive general liability insurance against bodily injury and property damage claims. The tenderer shall describe the insurance coverage and amount that will be maintained during this contract period.

By issuing this invitation the Resort Village of Turtle View is not bound in any way and does not have to accept the lowest or any tender.

TENDER OPENING:

Tenders will be opened at the regular Council meeting of April 17, 2024 at 7:00 p.m.
