TRAFFIC SPEED REGULATION BYLAW

RESORT VILLAGE OF TURTLE VIEW

BYLAW NO. 42-2024

A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF TURTLE VIEW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The council for the Resort Village of Turtle View in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the “Traffic Speed Regulation Bylaw”.

Purpose

2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to provide for the control of motor vehicle speed that adversely affect the safety of pedestrians, bikers and other motor vehicles on the Resort Village of Turtle View roads.

Definitions

3. In this Bylaw:
 - a) “highway” means a road, parkway, driveway, square or place designed and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles, but does not include any area, whether privately or publicly owned, that is primarily intended to be used for the parking of vehicles and the necessary passageways on that area;” as defined in *Traffic Safety Act, Chapter T-18.1 of the Statutes of Saskatchewan, 2004*;
 - b) “motor vehicle” means a vehicle propelled or driven by any means other than by muscular power; as defined in *the Traffic Safety Act, Chapter T-18.1 of the Statutes of Saskatchewan, 2004.*;
 - c) “speed zone” means any portion of a public highway within the Resort Village of Turtle View as designated herein, and identified by a sign indicating the maximum speed applicable thereto;

Speed Zones

4. Speed zones are hereby established within the Resort Village of Turtle View as 20km, 30 km and 60 km as posted on roads and stated on ‘Schedule A’ of this Bylaw.
5. Subject to the Traffic Safety Act and Section 4, hereof, no person shall operate a motor vehicle upon any portion of a public highway within the Resort Village of Turtle View to which Section 4 hereof is not applicable at a speed higher than 80 km.
6. Nothing in Section 4 or 5 hereof shall be deemed to apply to the operators of fire engines, fire department apparatus or to vehicles being operated by law enforcement officers or to the operators of ambulances, where these vehicles are being operated in emergency duty and employing the siren and flashing lights.

7. Signs indicating the maximum speed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end or speed change of the speed zone area.

Enforcement of Bylaw

8. Where any person has committed or is alleged to have committed a breach of any of the provisions of this Bylaw, a ticket, summary, or notice may be served on such person by a Police Officer, Municipal Enforcement Officer, or any person duly authorized by Council.

Coming Into Force


9. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of final reading thereof.

TRAFFIC SPEED REGULATION BYLAW #42-2024

'SCHEDULE A'

1. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than posted maximum on RVTV streets as follows: (Areas maps with speed details included)

Maximum of 60 km/hr:

- South end of the pavement on grid 697 at SW 22-53-18 W3 and north to Highways grid road (DNR Road) located at NW 27-53-18 W3
- Street from Grid 697 to Indian Point Golden Sands T-Section of Indian Point Dr. & Golden Sands Dr.

Maximum of 30 km/hr:

- Blais Dr. - Indian Point Dr. - Golden Sands Dr.

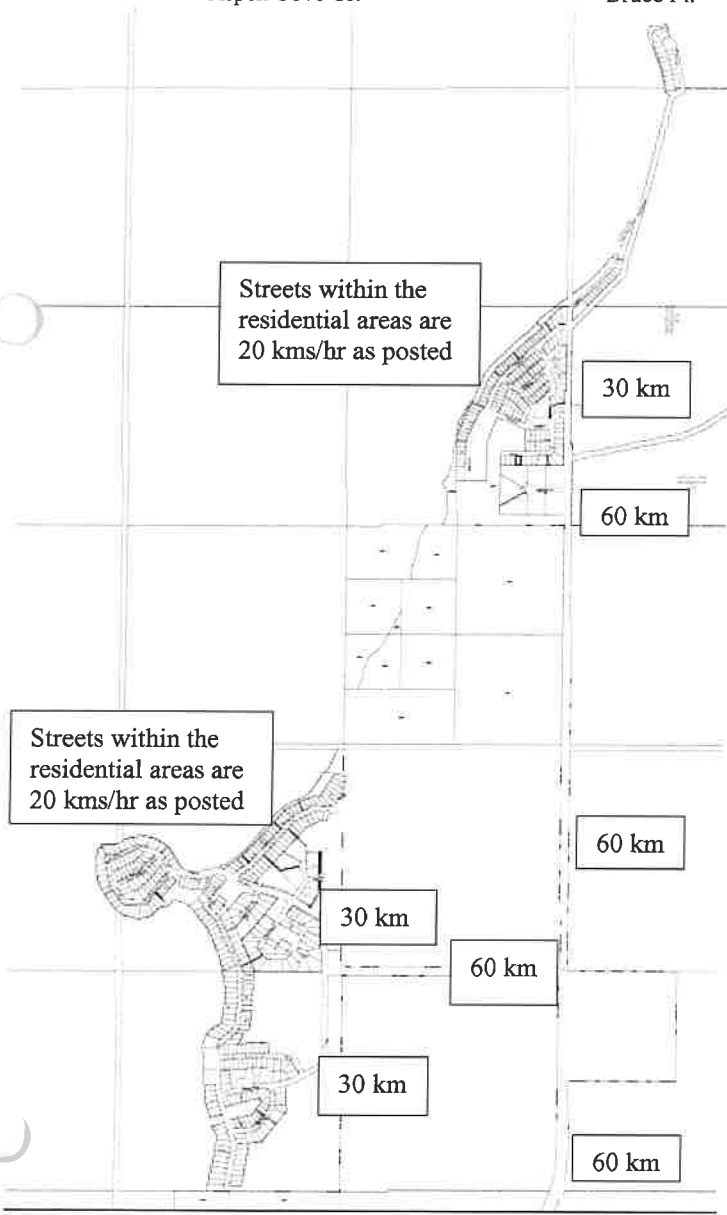
Maximum of 20 km/hr:

Turtle Lake Lodge Subdivision

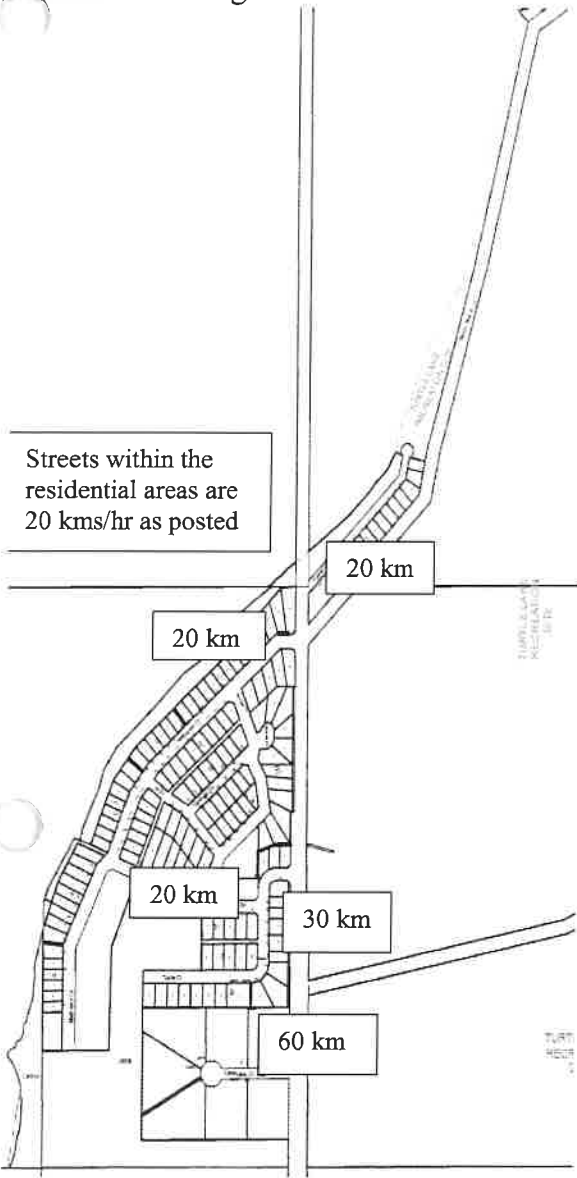
- Sandy Beach Dr. - Turtle Dr. - Corrial Cr. - Matthews Cr. - Corrigal Dr.

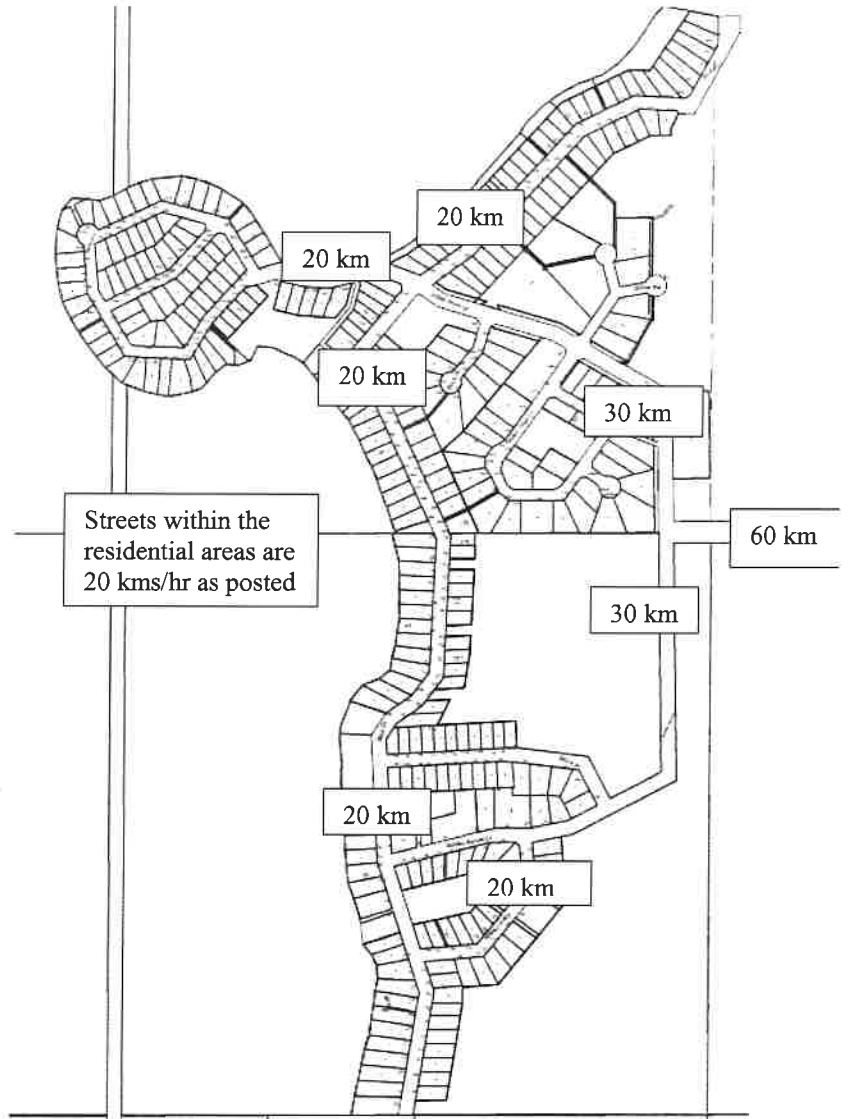
